To play snap:

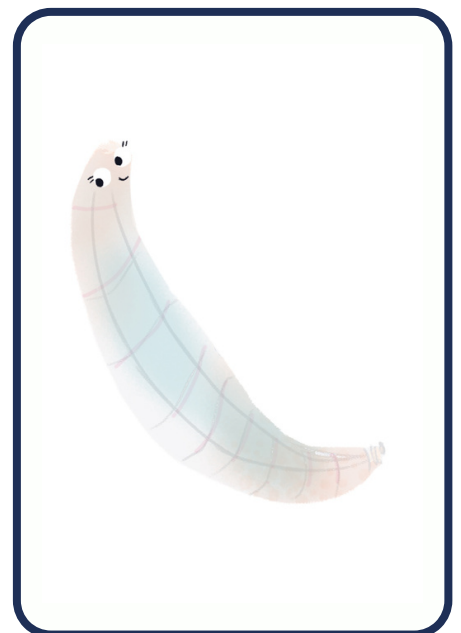
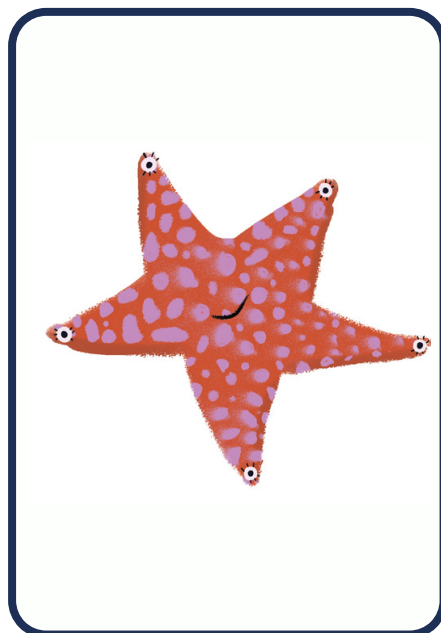
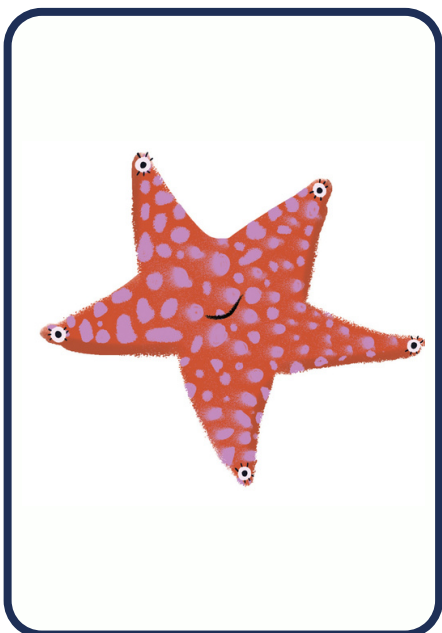
Shuffle the cards and divide them evenly between two players. Each player places their cards face down in a pile in front of them. Take turns turning a card over and placing it in a pile between you. When someone turns over a card that matches the card on the top of the pile shout "Snap!" The player who calls "Snap!" first wins the cards in the middle and adds them to the bottom of their face-down pile. Keep playing until one player wins all of the cards. That person is the winner!

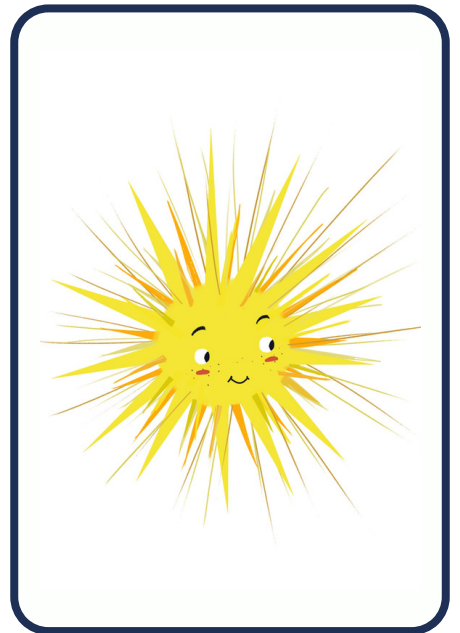
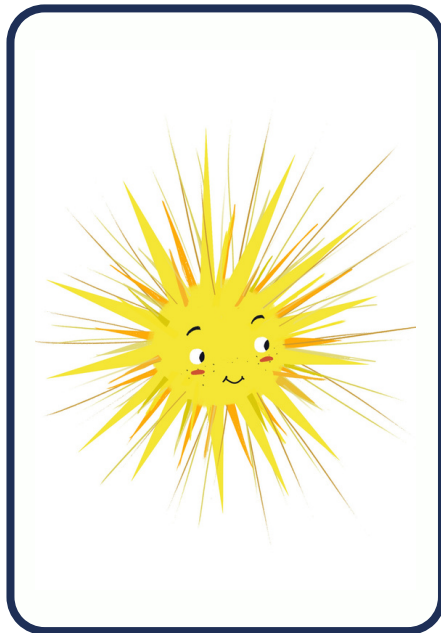
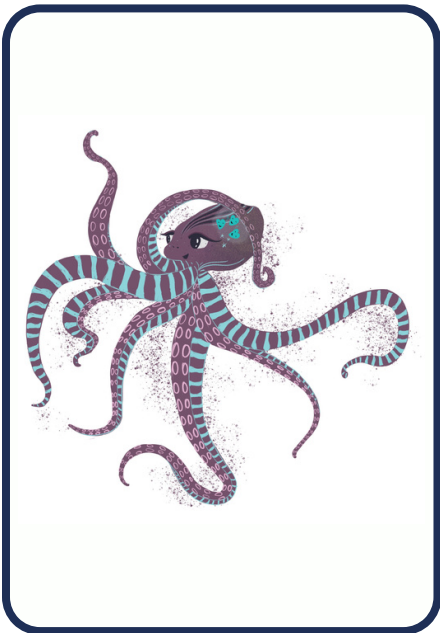
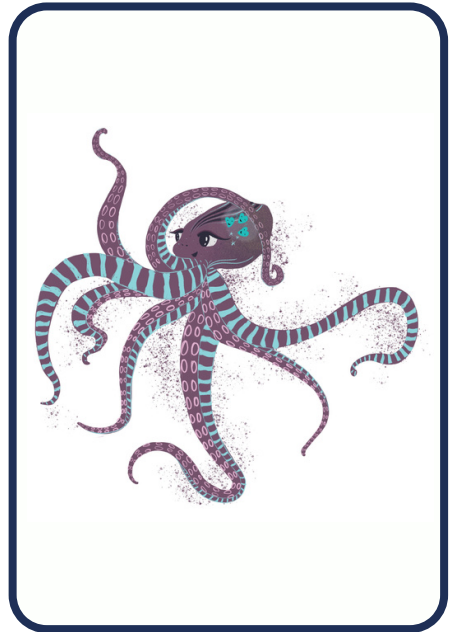
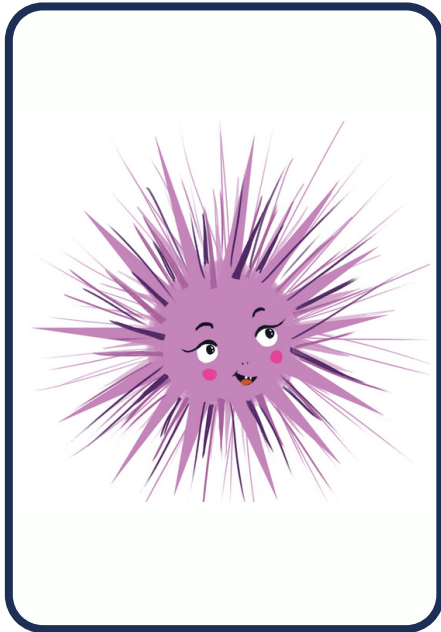
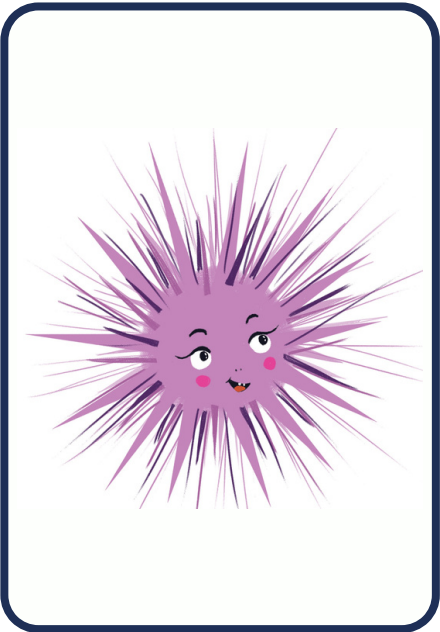
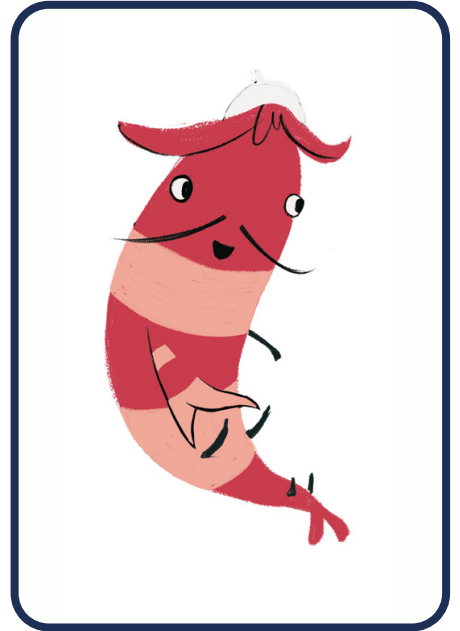
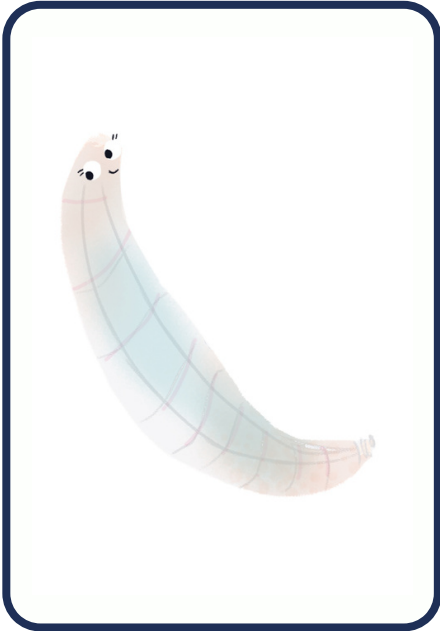
To play matching pairs:

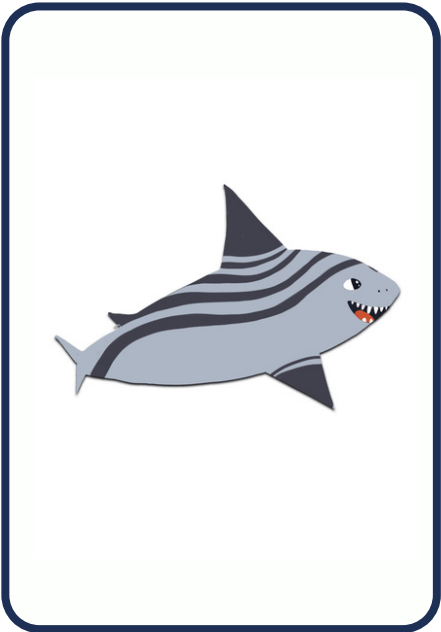
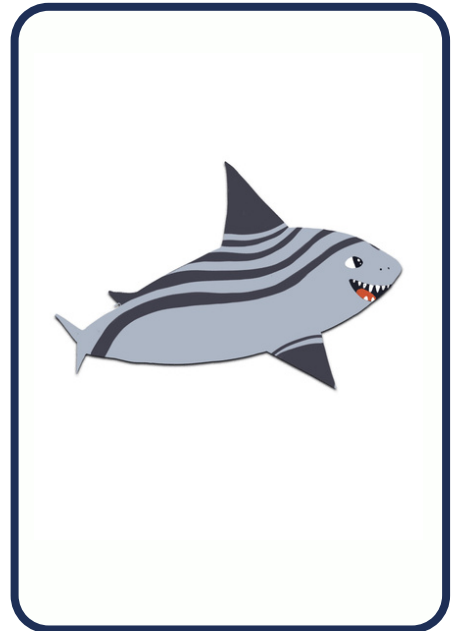
Shuffle the cards and place them face down on the table. The first player chooses two cards to turn over. If they are a matching pair they keep the cards and have another go. If they are not a pair, turn them back face down on the table. The second player now has a turn, trying to find a matching pair. The game continues until all matching pairs have been found. The winner is the player with the most pairs at the end of the game.

Remember:

When the gang play their games together they always have fun! Make sure you high-five your opponent at the end of each game and be a kind winner and a good loser!
